- Abiding → Godly dreams & desires → Fruit
- "De-Sire" in Latin means "of the Father" – Bill Johnson
 - Desires spring from what/whom we commune with
 - **Fantasy/Wishful thinking:** Has its roots in escapism, quick-fixes, fizzles out over time
 - **Godly desires/Dreams:** Develops step by step over time, convictions grow stronger, borne out of love, is selfless in nature

"A desire from God won't go away, you may have had it for years, but you still can't let it go... Or you may have let it go, but it won't let go of you"
