- Written in the time of great turmoil & trouble
- God's people under threat of external attacks
- Novel Corona Virus



2. The Blessings

a. Strength & courage – Ps 46: 1-3 (TPT)

¹ God, you're such a safe and powerful place to find refuge!
You're a proven help in time of trouble—
more than enough and always available whenever I need you.

² So we will never fear
even if every structure of support^[b] were to crumble away.
We will not fear even when the earth quakes and shakes,
moving mountains and casting them into the sea.

³ For the raging roar of stormy winds and crashing waves
cannot erode our faith in you.
Pause in his presence

- v1 → Always ready to help in times of trouble
 - o "Trouble" narrow or tight place
- v2-3 → Enable us to conquer our fears

b. Sustaining joy – Ps 46:4-6 (TPT)

⁴ God has a constantly flowing river whose sparkling streams bring joy and delight to his people.
His river flows right through the city of God Most High, into his holy dwelling places. [a]

⁵ God is in the midst of his city, ^[b] secure and never shaken.

At daybreak his help will be seen with the appearing of the dawn.

⁶ When the nations are in uproar with their tottering kingdoms, God simply raises his voice and the earth begins to disintegrate before him.
